A significant change for the Sport will be the Governmental change from the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation to the Ministry of Tourism and Sport. Although this seems like a minor change, government of the sport will change significantly. Compliance with much more legislation will be required, such as inclusivity, diversity, access etc. This will feed down from BCB to OLBA, OLBA to Club level.

As the ministry regulates the sport, it will be a case of comply or be cut off from funding and ability to represent Canada.
